RULES FOR A HIDDEN HOLES COMPETITION

- 1. Competition will be played from the yellow tees
- 2. The competition shall be Stableford format using full course handicaps
- 3. The number of strokes and Stableford points shall be recorded for all 18 holes
- Before the start of his round the competition organiser (Duty Roster) shall ask an impartial person to select nine scoring holes from the eighteen and place a record of those holes in a sealed envelope.
- 5. On completion of each group's round the markers shall identify the scoring holes and total up the corresponding Stableford points.
- 6. The competition winner shall be the player with the highest points score for the nine 'Hidden Holes'.
- If the scores are tied the places will be determined by scores on the last 4 hidden holes on the scorecard, then 2 followed by last hole.
