RULES for SUMMER Singles KO Competitions

Competitions are open only to paid up Lindfield Golf Club Members and Veteran Members who have an official active Handicap Index.

- All matches to be completed by designated date for that round
- All matches to be played off the White Tees.
- Full difference between course handicaps.
- Matches played over 18 holes. If scores are level after this then the match will continue with a play-off over holes 1, 2 and 3. If there is still no winner then it will continue with sudden death from hole 4. Handicap Index difference is reset from the start of the play off at hole 1 of the extra holes
- Winner to inform Competition Secretary of Result.
- If you are aware that an unexpected event has arisen and will prevent you participating in future rounds of the competition please concede your current match to allow the competition to proceed on time

Singles Knockout - The Guy Parsons Cup

To be played under match play rules. The competition will be organised by a random draw for round 1 and predetermined pathway for succeeding rounds. The winner will hold the Cup for a year and both finalists will receive commemorative awards.

Nick Flindall Plate

Players who lose their First match in The Guy Parsons will be entered into the Nick Flindall Plate. This a straight knock-out competition with a predetermined draw. Matches to be played under match play rules as indicated above for the Guy Parsons Cup The winner will hold the plate for a year and both finalists will receive commemorative awards.

Singles League / Knockout

Format/Rules

- All players must be signed up members of Lindfield Vets

Entry is £4 payable. Please pay your entry fee when signing in for a competition on any Friday.

- All players entering the competition will be placed in groups in which they will play and least 3 matches and no more than 4.
- All League matches to be completed by 31st July
- All matches to be played off white tees
- Players to play off course handicaps from white tees
- Matches to be played over 18 holes.
- 2 points to be given to the match winner, 1 point each for a halved match, 0 points for a loss. If a match is not played 0 points for either player (both players receive a -4 hole difference. If a match is conceded 2 points to the non-conceding player and a + 4 hole difference and 0 points to the conceding player and also a -4 hole difference.
- The winner and runner up from each group will progress to the knock out phase of the competition. Runners up in the group may well also qualify but this will be notified when the draw is made. The players will be placed in order of highest points to lowest points. If players have the same number of points then positions will be determined by hole difference of all league matches played (e.g. If a match finishes 3&2 or 3&1 the winner receives a hole difference of +3 and the loser -3). If qualifying positions still cannot be determined then match result between the players will decide and then an 18 hole playoff.
- If a player qualifies from the league but is unable to take up their place in the Knock out phase their place will be taken by the next highest placed person. Please inform the competition secretary immediately after final league tables are produced if this situation arises (within 48 hours)

Rules Regarding Summer Singles League Play Offs

- Matches to be played by Completion date
- All rules apply as above with the following exception:-
- If the match is all square after 18 holes then a 3 hole play off will follow (Holes 1,2 and 3) with handicap allowances in place. If the scores are still level then from hole 4 it becomes sudden death with the winner of the next hole being declared match winner.

Summer Greensomes League 2024

Rules of the Competition

- All players must be signed up members of Lindfield Vets and have an official WHS Handicap Index
- Entry Fee is £4 per player in cash
Please pay your entry fee when signing in for a competition on any Friday.
- Players select their playing pairs
- Pairings will be placed in groups whose size will be determined when number of entries are known.
- It is hoped that the group matches for each pair will be no less than 3 and no more than 4.
- All League matches to be completed by the date to be published
- All matches to be played off white tees
- Players handicaps to be determined by course handicap from white tees
- Matches to be played over 18 holes.
- 2 points to be given to the match winner, 1 point each for a halved match, 0 points for a loss. If a match is not played 0 points for either player (both players receive a -4 hole difference. If a match is conceded 2 points to the non-conceding team and a + 4 hole difference and 0 points to the conceding player and also a -4 hole difference. **If a date is arranged for a match and subsequently a player(s) is unable to fulfil the fixture**

unless a mutually convenient date within the time limit this pair forfeits the match.

- The teams will be placed in order of highest points to lowest points. The league winners will progress to the next round of the competition which is a Knockout and depending on number of entries best 2nd places may also progress*. If pairs have the same number of points then positions will be determined by hole difference of **all** league matches played (e.g. If a match finishes 3&2 or 3&1 the winner receives a hole difference of +3 and the loser -3). If qualifying positions still cannot be determined, then match result between the players will decide and then an 18 hole playoff within 7 days of the end of the group stage.
- *The number of teams qualifying for the knockout will be allocated when the draw for the group stage is made
- If a team qualifies from the league but is unable to take up their place in the Knockout phase their place will be taken by the next highest placed team. Please inform the competition secretary immediately after final league tables are produce if this situation arises (within 48 hours)
- It is highly unlikely that an extension will be given to play matches beyond the scheduled dates

The decision of the Competition Secretary acting on behalf of the committee is final. Any concerns to be sent to the Competition Secretary in writing (email sufficient)

Format of Greensomes

- Greensomes is a variation of Foursomes where both partners play from the teeing area and one of the two tee shots is selected. The partner whose tee shot was not selected then plays the next stroke and each subsequent stroke is made in alternating order until the ball is holed.
- The competition will be played over 18 holes off the white tees. Each player's handicap will be based on their playing handicap off the white tees at Lindfield GC.
- To calculate a handicap in Greensomes it should be 0.6 of the lower player's handicap and 0.4 of the higher player's. If both handicaps are equal, it should be half the combined total.

So, if Team 1's handicaps are four and eight and Team 2's six and eleven, the number of shots given to Team Two would be worked out as follows:

Team 1: (0.6×4) and $(0.4 \times 8) = 2.4 + 3.2 = 5.6$

Team 2: (0.6×6) and $(0.4 \times 11) = 3.6 + 4.4 = 8$

The difference is 2.4 so, rounding down, Team 1 would give Team 2 two shots. If the handicap difference is .5 or above the handicap difference is rounded up.
