



## **The Don Barrett Cup (Winter Singles)**

- This competition is open to all signed up members of both Lindfield Golf Club and The Veterans Section of the club with a WHS Index.
- Individual Winter Knock Out Competition played under match play rules
- There is an entry fee of £4
- Played off yellow Tees over 18 holes
- The handicap differential is the full difference in Playing Handicap off the yellow tees.
- If the scores are level after 18 holes then a 3 hole play-off is to follow over holes 1, 2 and 3. Handicap differences are reset at the start of the playoff. If there is still no outright winner then "sudden death" applies from hole 4
- The winner of the match to let The Competition Secretary know the result
- A regular update of results will be available on the Lindfield Vets Website- ([www.linfieldvets.co.uk](http://www.linfieldvets.co.uk))
- The dates for the completion of each round will be notified when the numbers entering the competition are known however it is hoped that there will at least 3 rounds before the end of the December.
- As soon as you know the player you are due to play please make arrangements to play the match as date extensions will only be given in very exceptional circumstances.
- Let the Competition secretary know if there are any concerns
- If you find out that you are not able to play in succeeding rounds it would be helpful if you withdraw from the competition and let your opponent go through to the next round of the competition

## Lindfield Vets

### The Ron Lower Cup (Winter Greensomes)

- This competition is open to all signed up members of both Lindfield Golf Club and The Veterans Section of the club with a WHS Index.
- Greensomes is a variation of Foursomes where both partners play from the teeing area and one of the two tee shots is selected. The partner whose tee shot was not selected then plays the next stroke and each subsequent stroke is made in alternating order until the ball is holed.
- It is open to fully signed up members of Lindfield Vets who have a WHS Index
- There is an entry fee of £2 per player
- Pairs are selected by a draw with each pair having a "lower handicapper" and a "higher handicapper". A list will be made of players entering the competition in handicap order with a line drawn half way down the list. A team will be made up of 1 player from the top half and one player for the lower half
- The competition will be played over 18 holes off the yellow tees. Each player's handicap will be based on their playing handicap off the yellow tees at Lindfield GC.
- If matches are tied after 18 holes a 3 hole play off over holes 1, 2 and 3 will follow followed by sudden death over holes from 4 until a conclusion is reached. Handicaps are reset for the start of the play off
- As soon as you know who you are due to play please make arrangements to play your match within the time schedule as extensions will only be given in very exceptional circumstances.
- Although the completion dates for each round will not be confirmed until the number of teams are known there will be at least 2 rounds to be played by the end of the year.
- If there are any concerns about the format/ matches please contact The Competition secretary.
- The Competition Secretary's decision is Final.

- If you find out that you will become unavailable for later rounds of the competitions it would be helpful if you would concede your match and allow your opponents through to the next round
- To calculate a handicap in Greensomes use 0.6 of the lower player's playing handicap off the yellow tees and 0.4 of the higher player's. If both handicaps are equal, it should be half the combined total.

*So, if Team 1's playing handicaps are four and eight and Team 2's six and 11, the amount of shots given to Team Two would be worked out as follows:*

**Team 1:**  $(0.6 \times 4)$  and  $(0.4 \times 8) = 2.4 + 3.2 = 5.6$

**Team 2:**  $(0.6 \times 6)$  and  $(0.4 \times 11) = 3.6 + 4.4 = 8$

*The difference is 2.4 so, rounding down, Team 1 would give Team 2 two shots. If the difference is .5 or greater then the handicap is rounded up*

*The above rules can be amended at the discretion of Lindfield Vets Committee*
